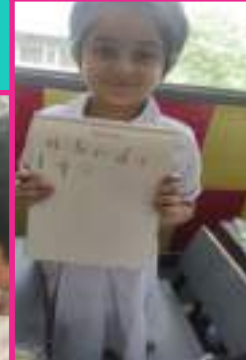
TOYTHON – TOY MAKING WORKSHOP

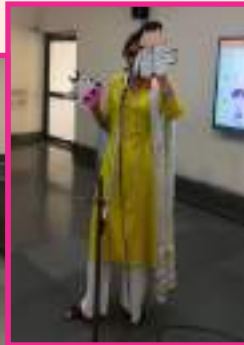
CHECKMATE- OPEN CHESS COMPETITION

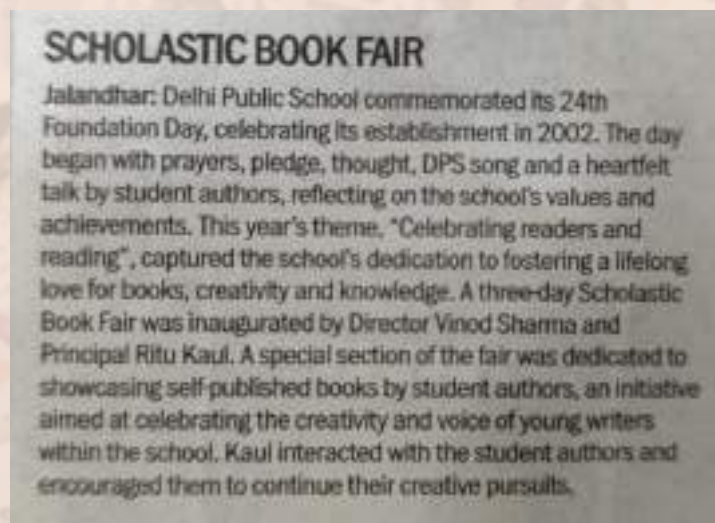
