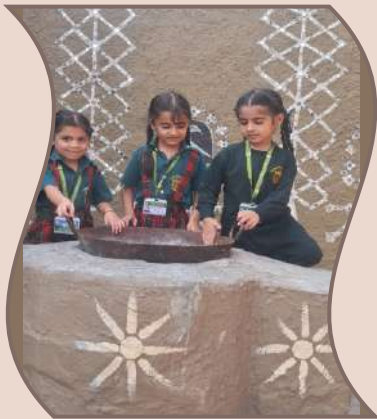

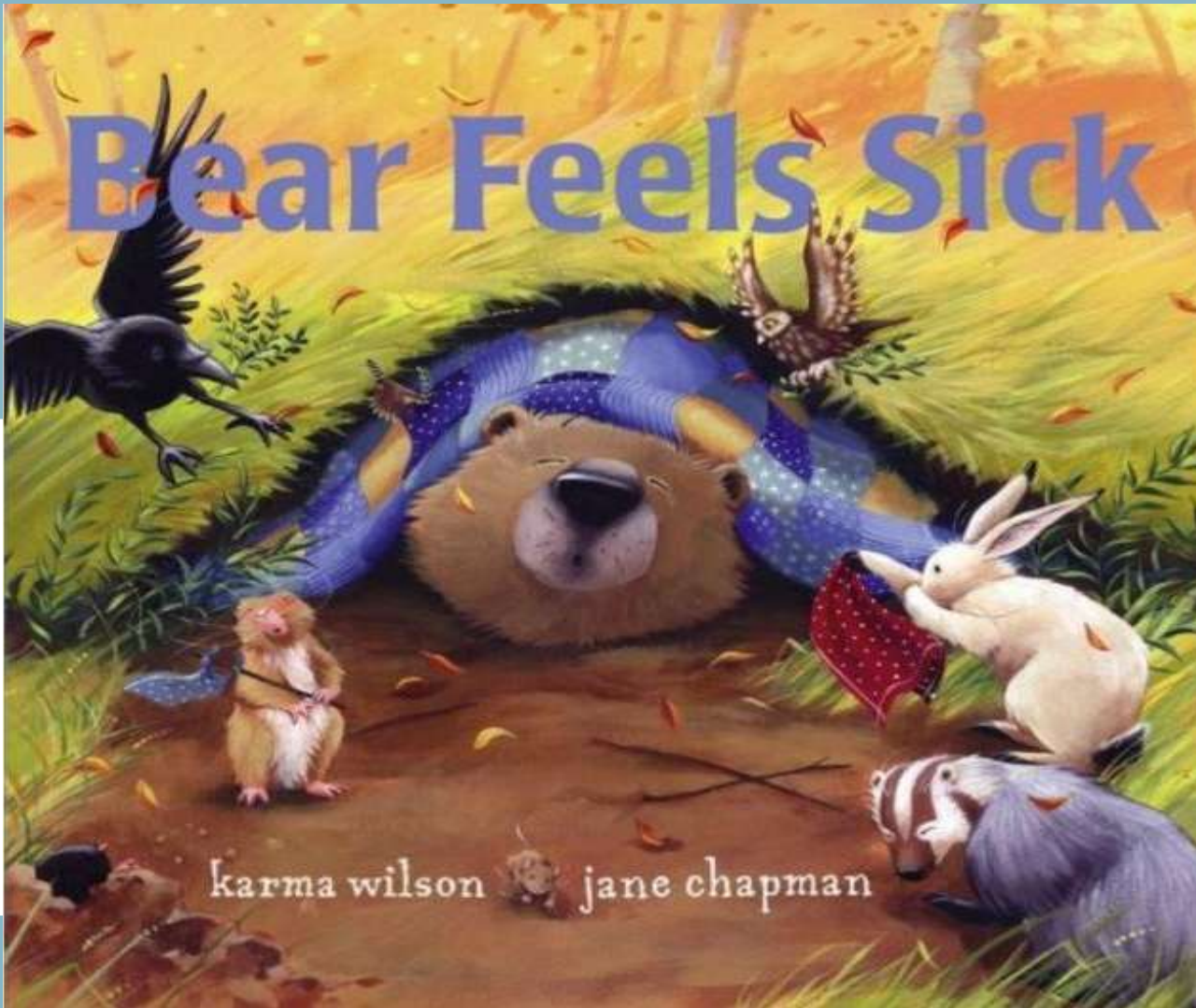

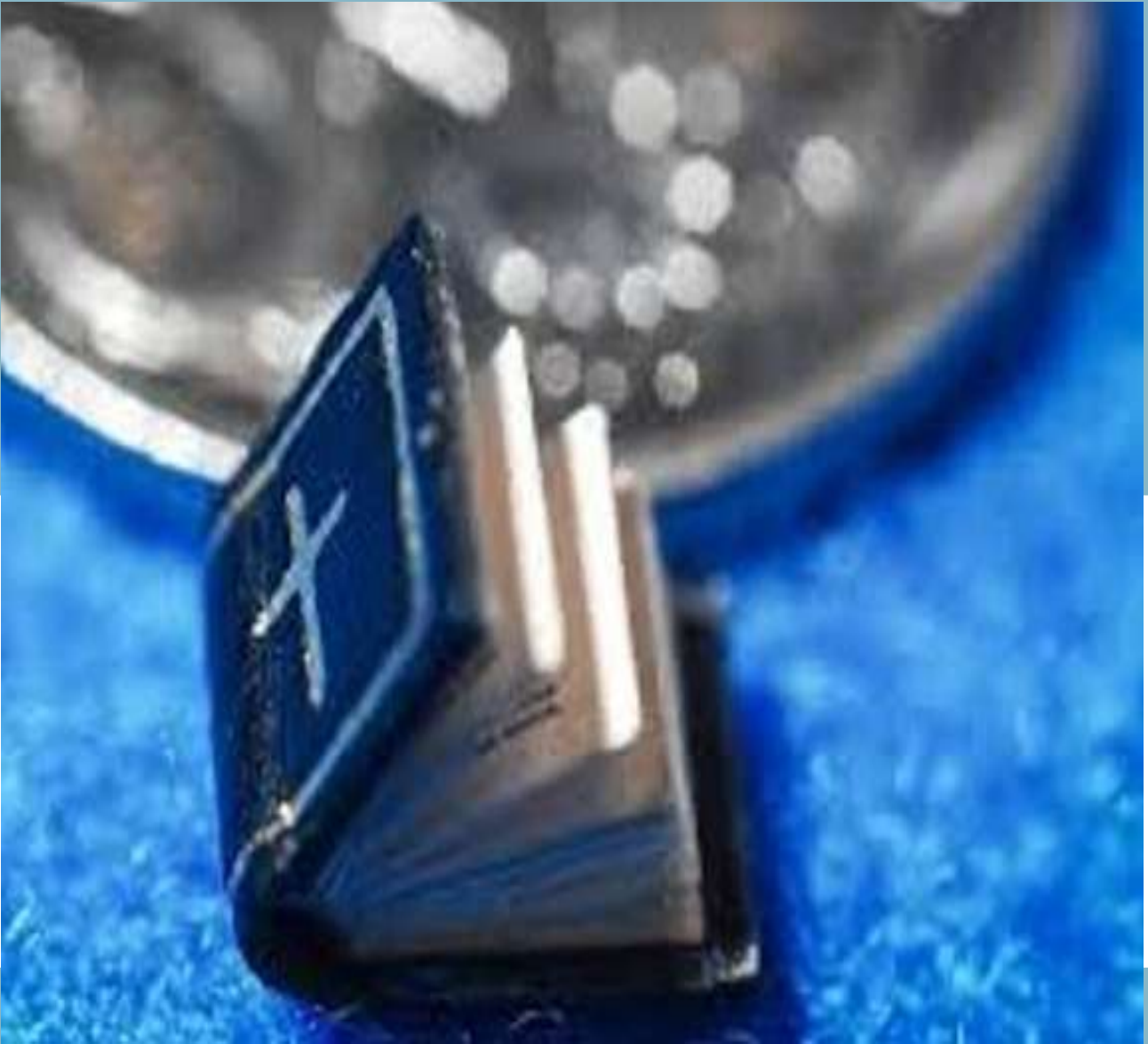
READER'S NEST

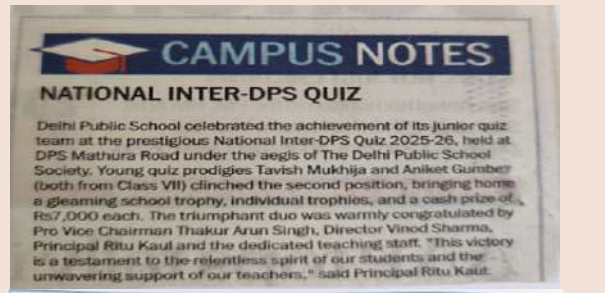
