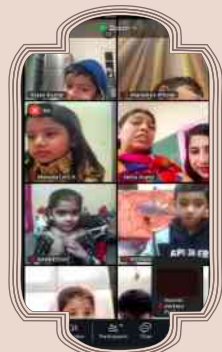
RAUNKAN LOHRI DIYAN - LOHRI CELEBRATION - 12 JANUARY

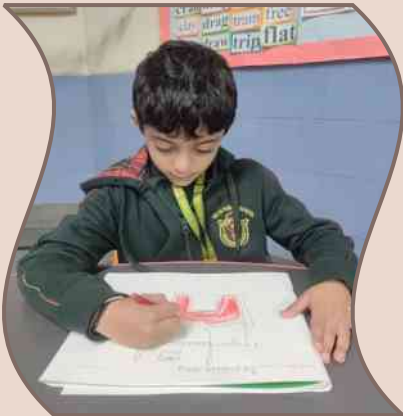
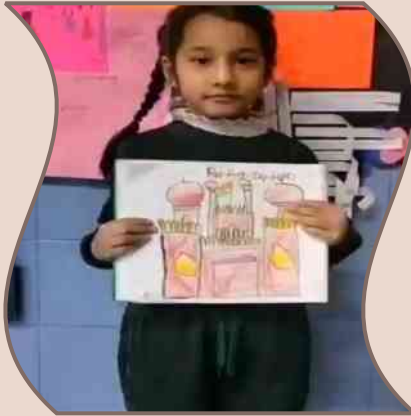

The programme commenced with a student-led presentation of the Annual Report, followed by an insightful theme speech on the transformative power of movement and the ceremonial lighting of the

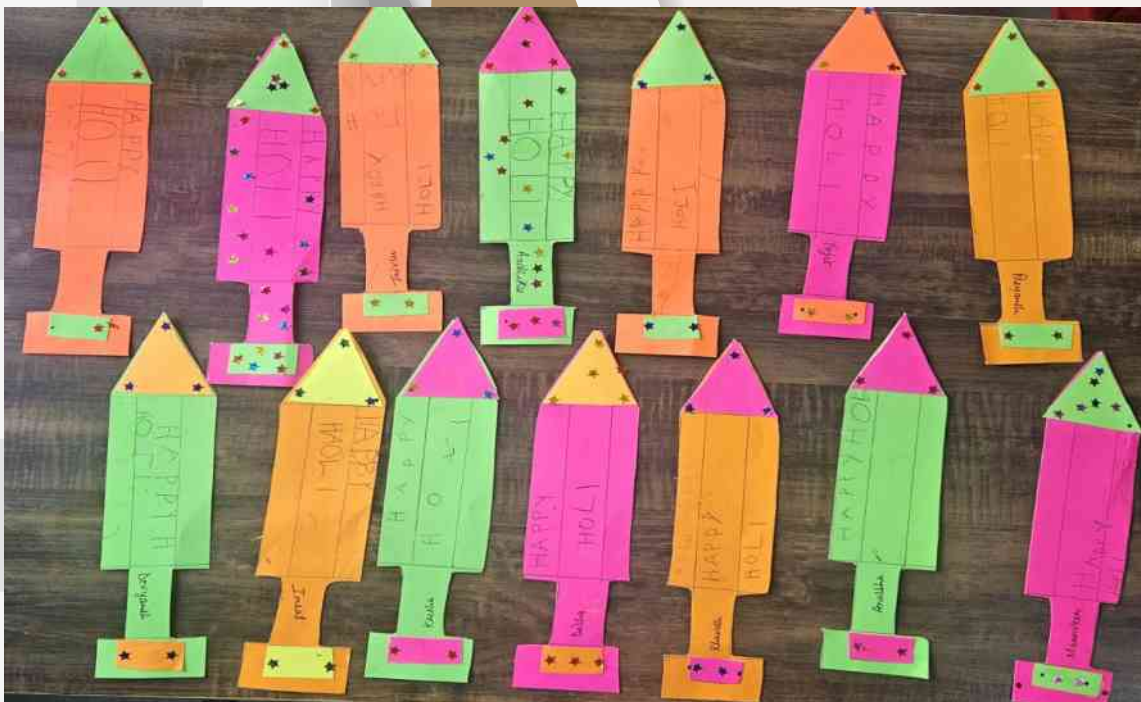

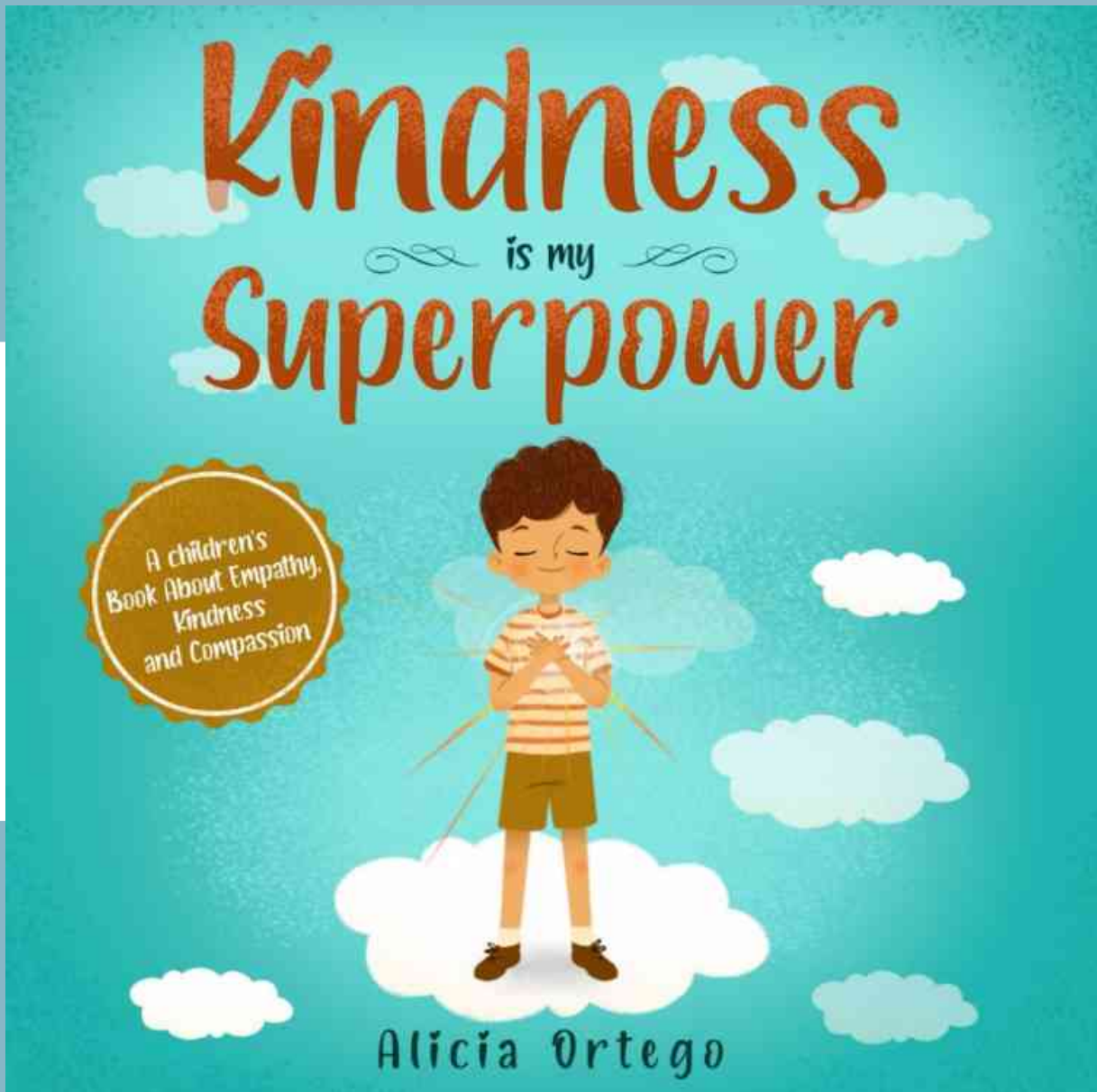

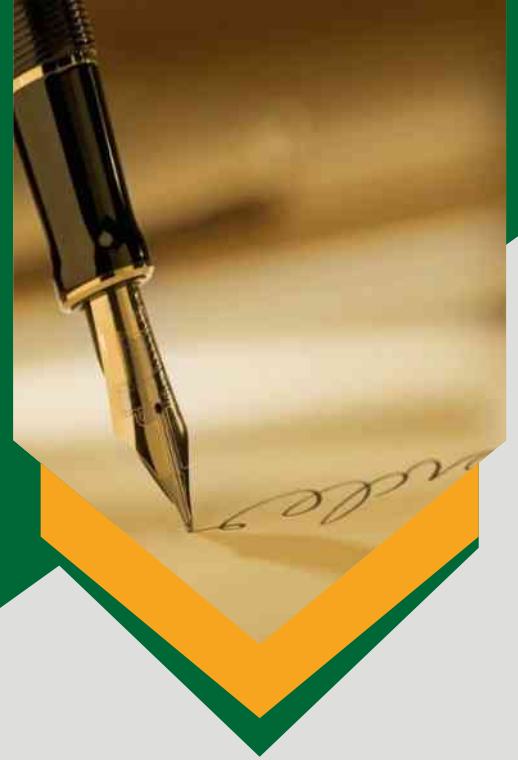
